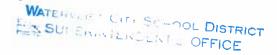

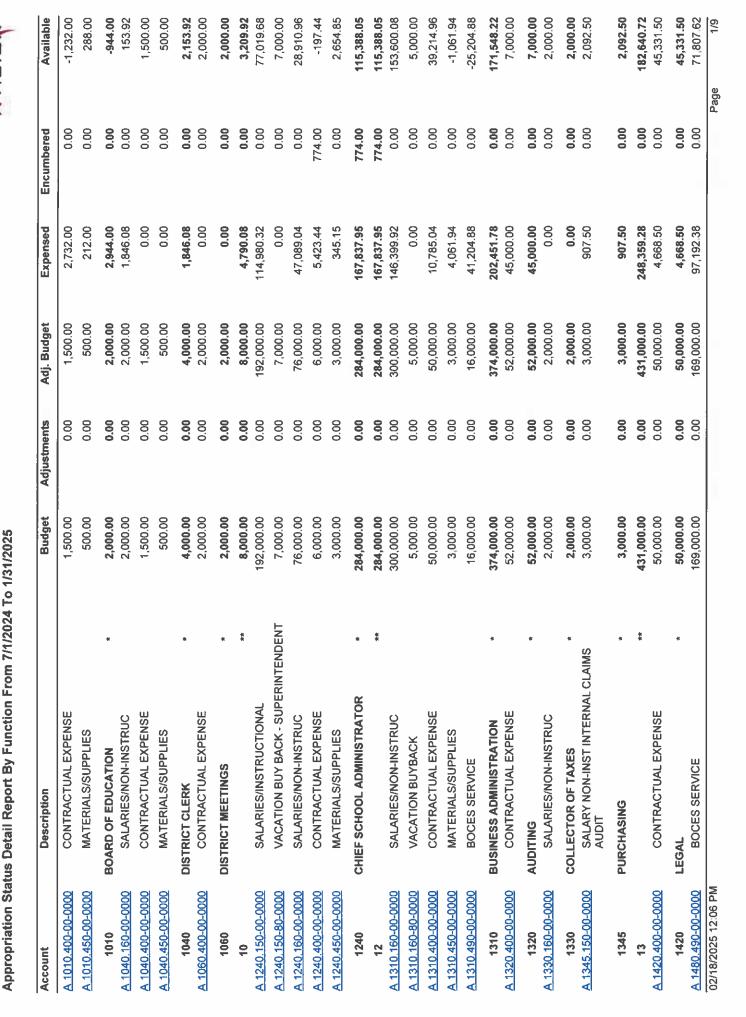

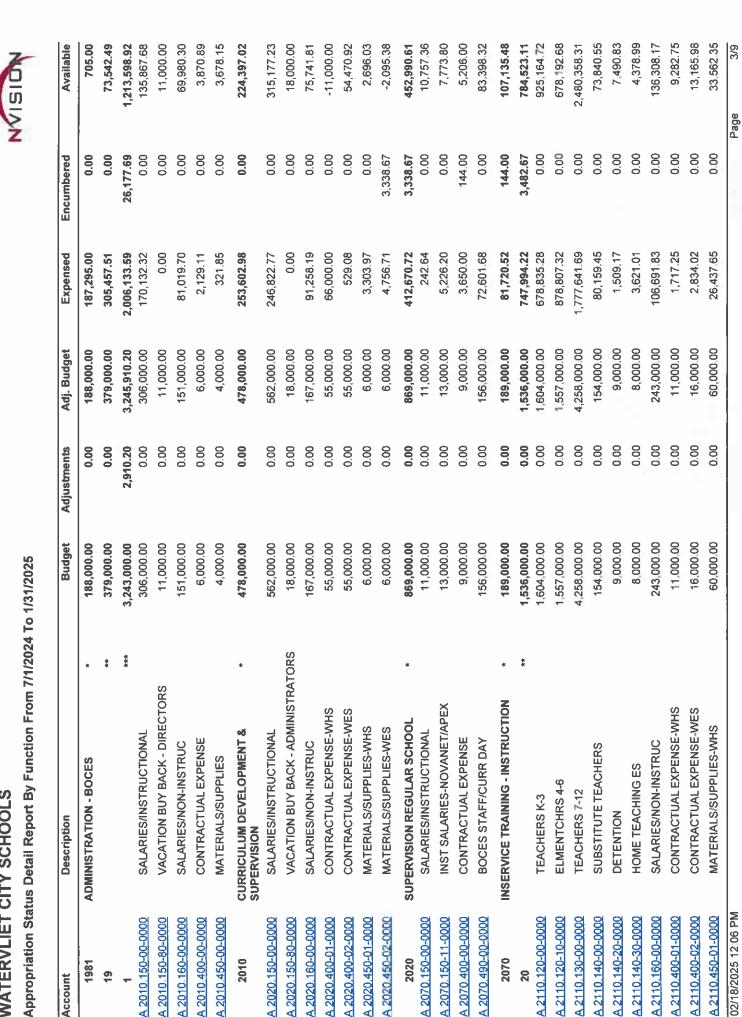

Tuition & Transition Plan for Green Island Students Presentation

Dr. Donald Stevens Jr.

Mrs. Whited asked if the numbers anticipated after next year and going forward will increase.

Dr. Stevens responded that the numbers increase a bit, but not so much that it will impact class size. He noted that as enrollment continues to increase, aid will increase, which will provide more opportunities for added sections and electives. Green Island would also pay more for non-resident tuition.

Mrs. Soroka asked if there is a relationship between regionalization and tuitioning.

Dr. Stevens responded that there is a relationship. Green Island and Watervliet are regionalizing this approach. We have also regionalized with our Riverside agreement with multiple neighboring districts. As outlined in our Regionalization Plan, it is working as a region to offer more opportunities for students. New graduation measures are coming out soon and small districts are struggling with how they are going to attend to many pathways to provide for a student to graduate. At this time, we only know that they are saying "no more regents," but there will still have to be a pathway through social studies, ELA, etc. A small district will have a hard time creating all of those unique opportunities for student success. For example, Green Island doesn't have a music program, but now they will have the ability to participate in a music program.
